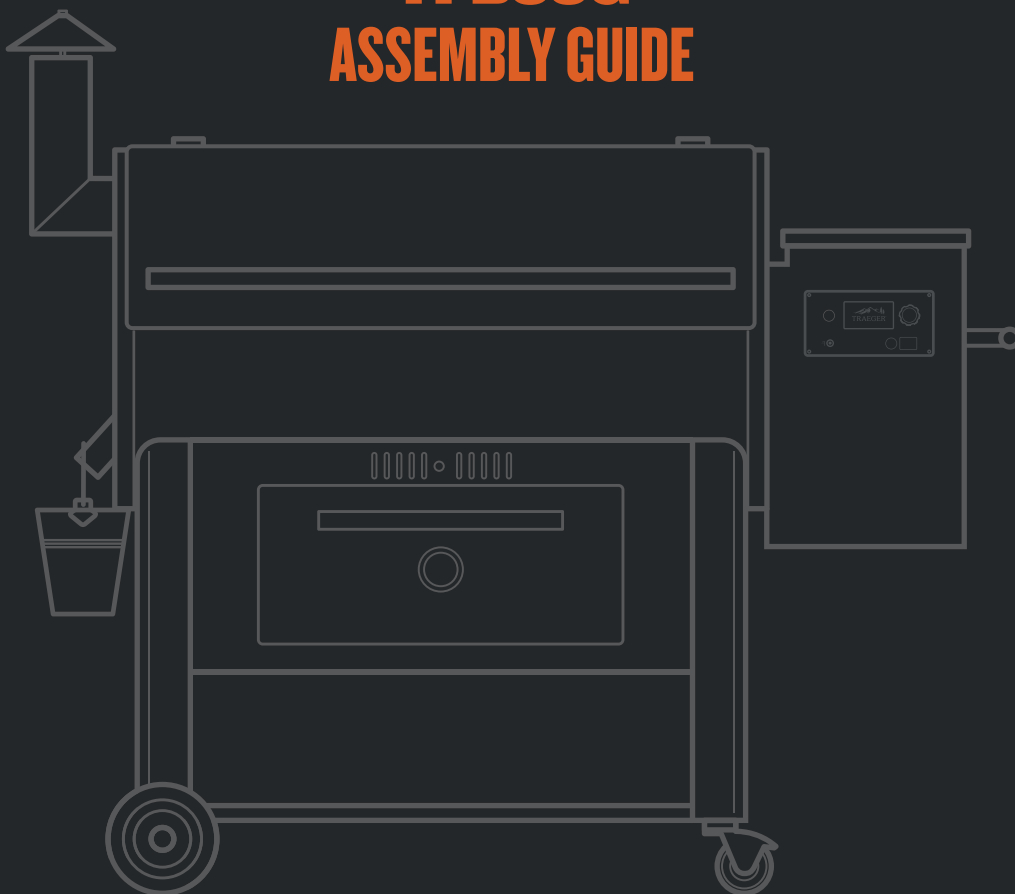

WARNING!

MANY PARTS OF THE GRILL WILL BECOME VERY HOT DURING OPERATION. CARE MUST BE TAKEN TO AVOID BURNS, BOTH DURING OPERATION AND AFTERWARDS, WHILE THE GRILL IS STILL HOT.

Never leave the grill unattended when young children are present.

Never move the grill when it is operating.

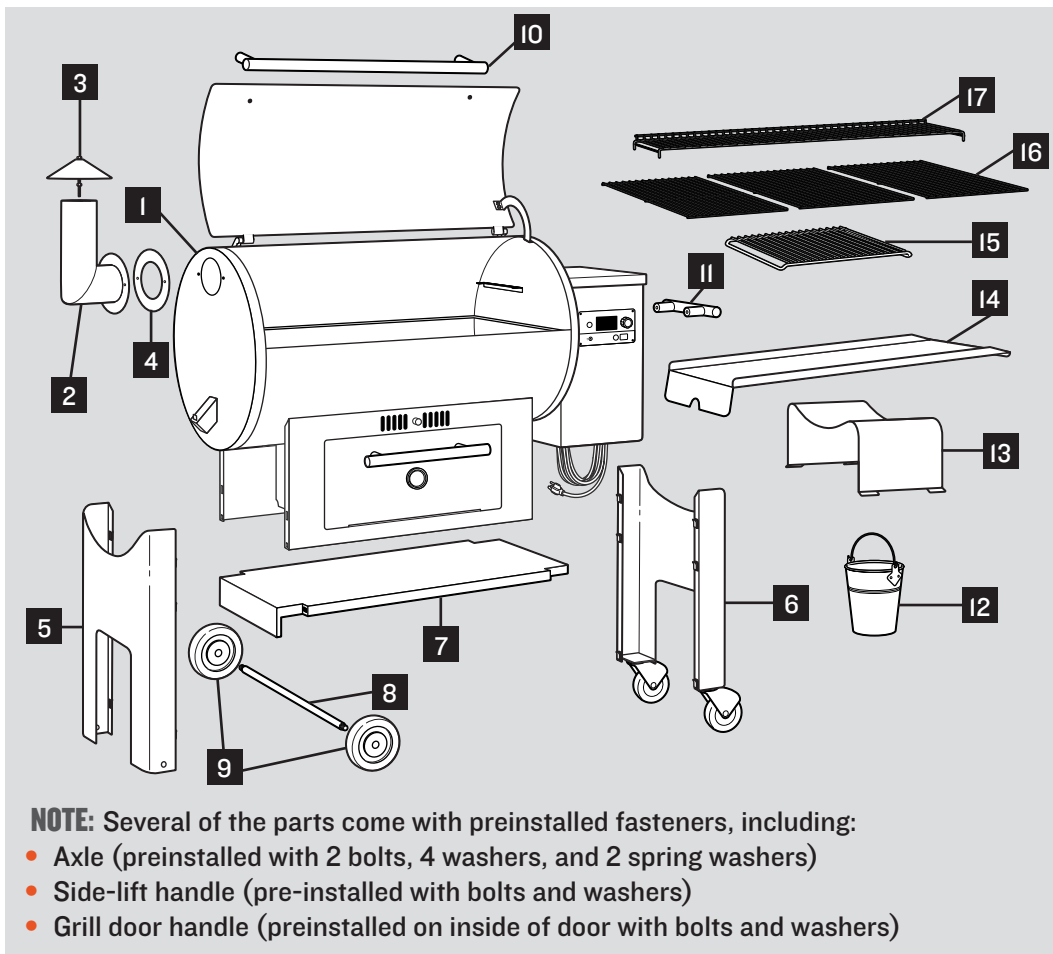
Let the grill cool completely before moving or attempting to transport.

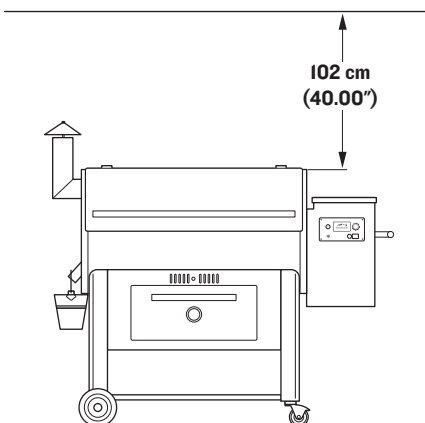

BLISTER PACK PARTS NEEDED

- A** Bolts: 1/4"-20x0.6" (10 pcs)
 - B** Spring Washers: 1/4" (8 pcs)
 - C** Washers: 1/4" (8 pcs)
 - D** Washers: 1/4" (4 pcs)
 - E** Hex Nuts: 1/4"-20 (2 pcs)
- Wrench (2 pcs)

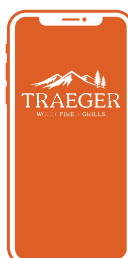
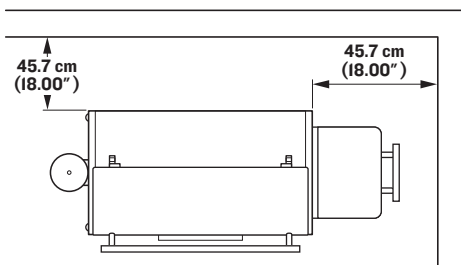


WARNING!

- When operating this grill under overhead combustibles, a **MINIMUM** of 102 cm (40 inches) is required.
- When operating this grill, maintain a **MINIMUM** distance of 45.7 cm (18 inches) from the grill to combustibles.

IMPORTANT!

- The grill is very heavy. Always lift the grill with **TWO** people.

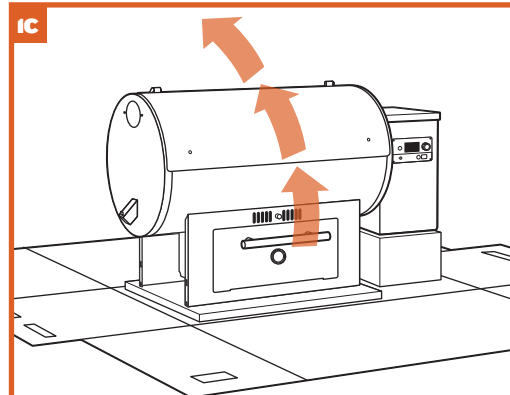
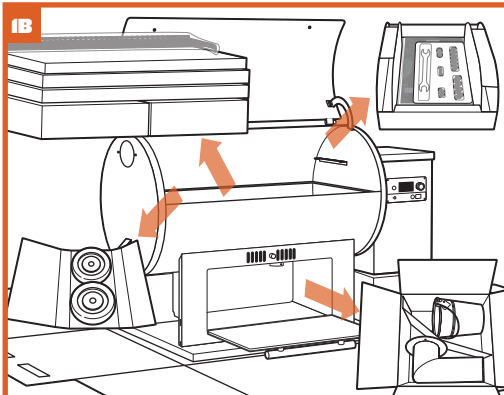
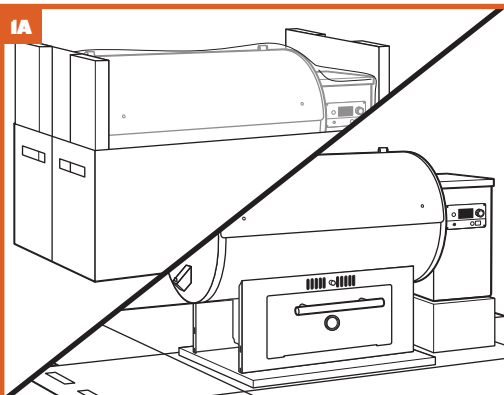
Traeger'ing is more fun with friends! (No, really, you will need two people to lift the grill.)

1 UNPACK COMPONENTS AND FLIP OVER GRILL

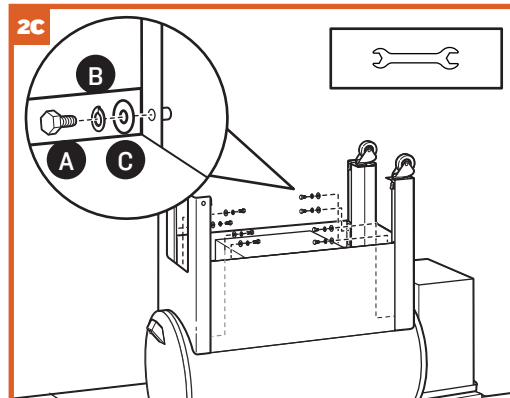
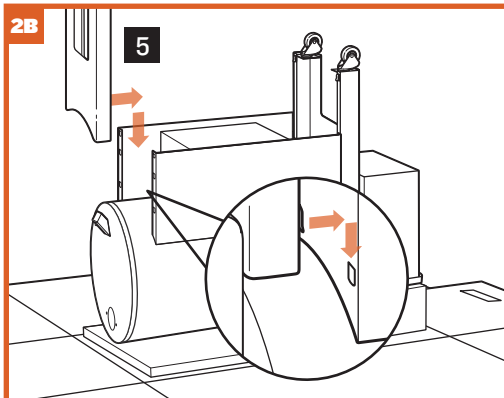
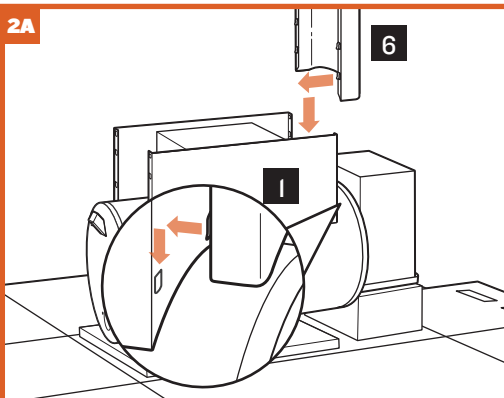
NOTE: The lower shelf **7** is taped to the inside of the upper box, but may slide inside the lower box during shipping.

NOTE: Grill is secured in box with multiple cardboard pieces, some of which hold grill parts. Be sure to check ALL packaging for parts as you unpack them.

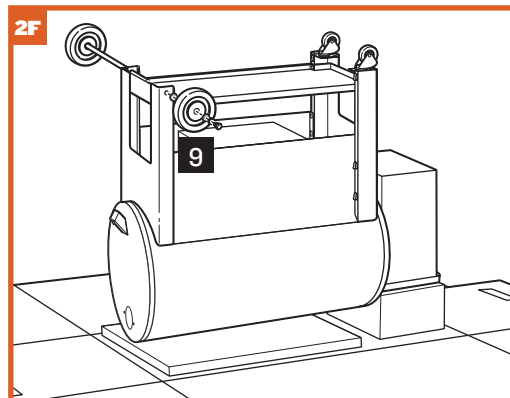
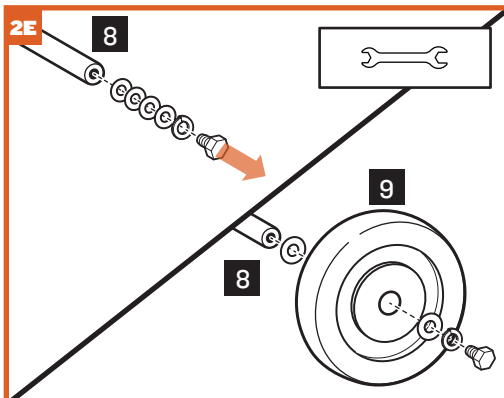
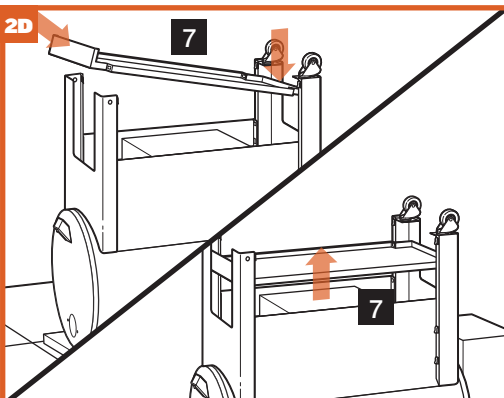
THIS WILL REQUIRE TWO PEOPLE.



2 INSTALL LEGS



NOTE: Legs have a clip feature that matches up with corresponding slots on the grill body. Do not fully tighten leg bolts at this time.

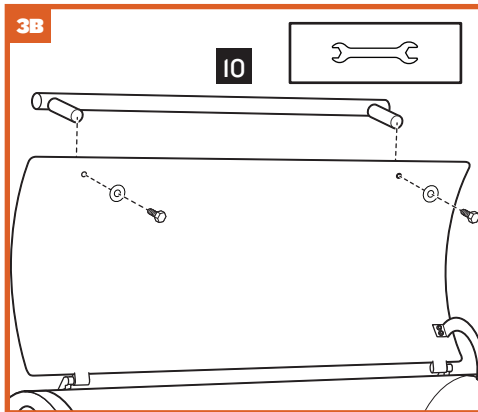
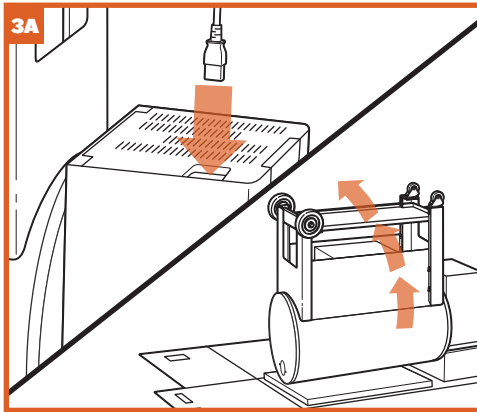


NOTE: After the bottom shelf is installed, fully tighten all leg bolts (Step 2C).

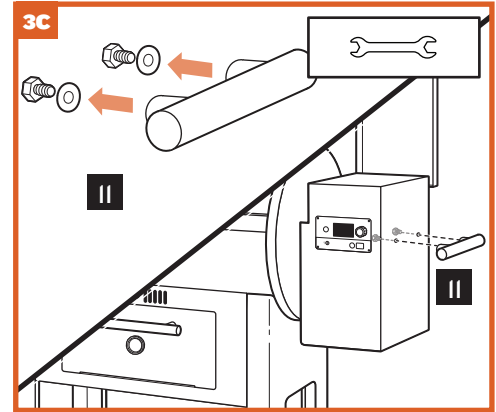
NOTE: Fasteners are preinstalled on the axle.

3 ASSEMBLE UPPER GRILL COMPONENTS

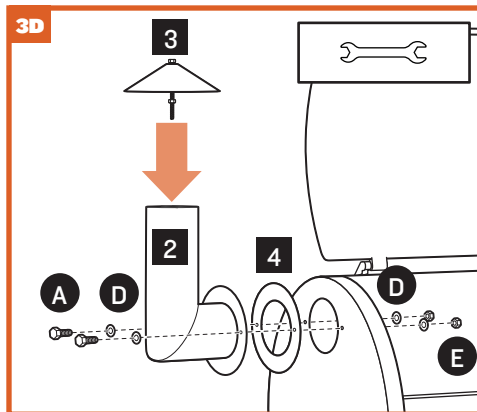
THIS WILL REQUIRE TWO PEOPLE.



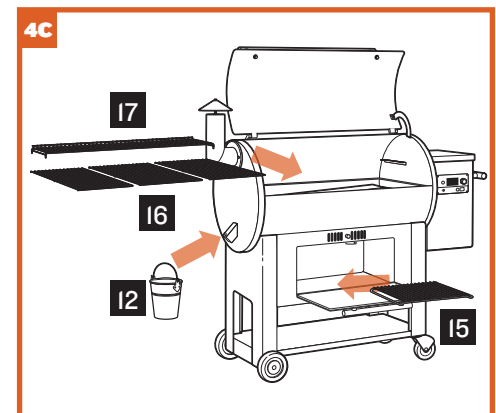
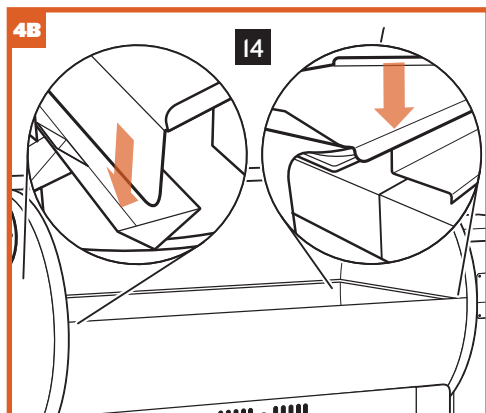
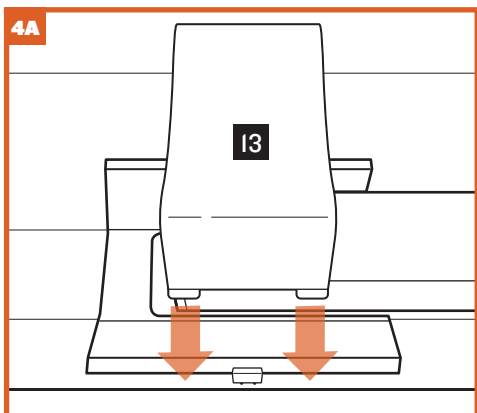
NOTE: Fasteners for lid handle are preinstalled on handle.
